Prof. Dr. med. Reto Auer, MD, MAS, is a primary care physician and clinical researcher. He is an Associate Professor (Extraordinarius) at the Institute of Primary Health Care (BIHAM) at the University of Bern, Head of the Substance use Unit, where he leads a variety of research projects, including a large randomized controlled trial designed to test the efficacy, safety and toxicology of nicotine vaporizers (E-cigarettes) (<https://www.estxends.ch/>) and another trial testing the effect of the regulation of cannabis for non-medical use on health and social outcomes of consumers (<https://www.script-studie.ch/>). He has been an Adjunct Physician at the Department of Community and Ambulatory Care at the University of Lausanne, since January 2017. He trained as an internist physician in Switzerland and was awarded a Masters in Advanced Studies (MAS), with a focus on implementation and dissemination sciences, at the University California San Francisco (UCSF) in 2014.
