



International Medical Cannabis Conference Bern 2025, IMCCB-25 University of Bern, Switzerland, 13-14 February 2025

Abstract will be uploaded as a word file via the **Conftool** upon registration (see main page). You can submit an abstract without having yet paid the conference fee. Please follow the below instructions for the submission of your file. We will consider the best abstracts for oral presentations, and you may choose poster or oral. The best poster and oral presentation will be awarded to young researchers. All abstracts will be published in a special issue of *Medical Cannabis and Cannabinoids*.

Abstract Guidelines

Format:

- Title (Arial 11, bold; short, precise)
- First (initials) and family names (Arial 10, bold, presenting author, affiliation¹)
- ¹Affiliation, postal code, city (Arial 9, italic)
- Text: 250-350 words (Arial 11, normal, not justified, line spacing 1)
- 1 page, Word file, no PDF; written in English.

Structure:

- Introduction
- Aims
- Methods
- Results
 - 1 Figure or table (optional); tables, figures, and references must be referred to in the text
- Conclusions
- Keywords (max. 5)
- References (max. 3, optional)
- Acknowledgements.

- Submission: online via ConfTool.
- ❖ All abstracts are peer-reviewed by the Scientific Committee.
- ❖ Submission deadline: 31 December 2024.
- ❖ Abstract journal: Medical Cannabis and Cannabinoids (Karger Publishers, Basel, Switzerland) is the official journal of IMCCB-25. All accepted abstracts will be published online and open access. Processing requires 6 weeks, therefore, abstracts received after the strict deadline will not be published.
- Presentation types: poster presentation or short oral communication (1 session with five 15-min talks, each).
- The Scientific Committee decides if an abstract is suited for an oral presentation or not.

Poster Guidelines

Format:

- A0 portrait (W 118.9 x H 84.1 cm) or landscape (W 118.9 x H 84.1 cm). Preferably, posters should be printed on one sheet of paper.
- The text, illustrations, etc. should be bold enough to be read from a distance of two meters.
- Structure: The posters must be structured as the abstract, with title and authors as stated in the abstract.
- ❖ Poster number: Communicated after abstract acceptance, same as for abstract. Based on the presented research topics abstracts and posters will be attributed to sub-groups.
- Poster mounting: Thursday 13 February, 8:00-11:30 (latest). Tacks and technical equipment will be available for the mounting of posters.
- Poster dismantling: Friday 14 February 15-17:00 (latest).
- Poster location: Poster Area in the Exhibition & Networking Hall.
- Poster viewing and discussions: during lunch and coffee breaks each day. Authors will be kindly requested to stand by their posters to present their work and answer questions.
