Prof. Rudolf Brenneisen studied Pharmaceutical Sciences and got his PhD in Phytochemistry and Pharmacognosy at the University of Bern (UniBE). Then he was head of the Dept. of Phytochemistry and Pharmacognosy as well as the Analytical Toxicology Unit at the Institute of Pharmacy UniBE, was promoted to Assoc. Prof. and head of the Laboratory for Phytopharmacology, Bioanalytics and Pharmacokinetics at the Dept. of Clinical Research UNIBE. He served as consultant and expert for UN International Drug Control Programme (UNDCP) and Swiss Federal Office of Public Health, Div. of Pharmaceuticals and Narcotics. Until 2014 and 2024, respectively, he was president and secretary general of the Swiss Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences (SAPhS). He is co-founder and board member of Swiss Society of Cannabis in Medicine (SSCM), founder and owner of MedCanSult, and serves as editor-in-chief for Medical Cannabis and Cannabinoids. He is an author of more than 200 articles in peer-review journals and books. He is fellow of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences (AAFS) and honorary member of the Bernese Assoc. of Pharmacists.
