

Kirsten Müller-Vahl, MD

Prof. Dr. Kirsten Müller-Vahl is Professor of Psychiatry at the Department of Psychiatry, Social Psychiatry and Psychotherapy at the Medical School of Hannover (MHH), Germany. She is a specialist in neurology and adult psychiatry. Since 1995, she has been head of the outpatient department for Tourette's syndrome at MHH. She chairs the National Association for Cannabinoid Medicines (ACM) and the International Alliance for Cannabinoid Medicines (IACM). At the 9th IACM Conference, she received the "2017 IACM Clinical Research Award for special achievements in the reintroduction of cannabis and cannabinoids as medicine". Dr. Müller-Vahl has published more than 200 scientific articles, is author of several book chapters and textbooks. She is associate editor of the journal Cannabis and Cannabinoid Research and a member of the editorial board of the journal Medical Cannabis and Cannabinoids.
